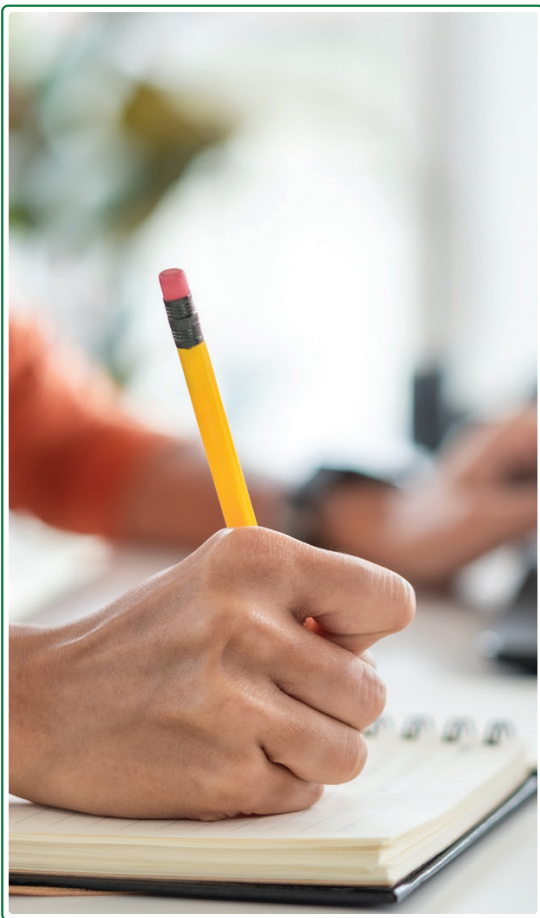


Falling behind on FERPA?
